Dear Parents,

The children and staff are working very hard. I am delighted with the enthusiasm of all the children especially the Y6 children who are coping very well with extra booster sessions and interventions. On Tuesday Essex County Council carried out a Safeguarding Audit on the school. I am pleased to say that we have done very well in this audit and that Essex County Council have written a report saying the children are safe and very well looked after.

It is interesting to see that the age of consent to use the app, Whatsapp has increased to 16 years old.
