Thank you to the Chairs of Govenors, Governors, the church, neighbours, parents, LIFE staff and all the staff at our schools. The staff and myself have been working very hard in the background, trying to help you as much as they can. This is a very difficult position for all of us to be put in at very short notice and we hope to be back to normal, however I do not know when that will be, unfortunately.
