Please can you take the time to make sure that your child's uniform is labelled and that you have the correct uniform for your child at home. 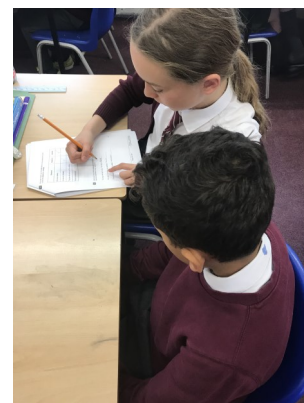
